A new Florida Statute requires charter schools that do not receive a school grade but serve at least 10 students who are tested on the statewide assessment to report student performance data.

**In order to receive a school grade of an “A” from the Florida Department of Education a school must receive 525 points. *Lakeland Montessori received 654 points.***
